

HOW TO PLAY LOTTO STRIKE

Use black or blue ink. Do not use red ink.

Strike is an add-on game and can only be played when playing Lotto. The object of the game is to correctly select the first four Lotto numbers in the exact order drawn on the Lotto draw.

- Each entry form contains nine (9) game panels, each containing a set of numbers from one (1) to forty-five (45). Each standard game may be played.
- In each game panel, select one number per line between 1 and 45 inclusive by marking with a cross (X). For example, if you choose number 38, just mark 30 and 8. If you choose 5, mark 5 only. If you choose number 20, mark 20 only and if you choose 14, mark 10 and 4. Like this:

- The number on your first line will be your first ball, the number on the second line will be your second ball and so on.
- Select the draw/s you wish to enter by marking Mon and/or Wed and/or Sat where indicated on the entry form. To play all three draws mark Mon, Wed and Sat.
- If you would like your four numbers boxed, mark "Boxed Selection". A Boxed Selection gives you 24 combinations of your four numbers and means that your four numbers can be drawn in any order within the first four Lotto balls. Boxing your numbers is equivalent to 24 Standard games. Only one panel on each entry form may be completed.

Strike 3	3 numbers in order drawn	21,804:1
Strike 2	2 numbers in order drawn	346:1
Strike 1	1 number in order drawn	12:1

CLAIMING YOUR PRIZE

- Up to \$1,000** Take your winning ticket (within the prescribed period) to any NSW Lotteries Agency with a computer linked terminal for verification and immediate payment. Registered players' prizes not claimed within eight weeks of draw will be sent by post.
- Over \$1,000** Unregistered players must contact NSW Lotteries to obtain information on how to claim a prize. Registered players' prizes will automatically be sent by post within the prescribed period.

LOTTO STRIKE CONDITIONS

- All entry forms, tickets, players and winners are governed by the provisions of the Public Lotteries Act 1996 and regulations, the Lotto Strike rules, these conditions and any legislation, rules, conditions or directions respectively replacing or amending same.
- By entering a game of Lotto Strike, a player agrees to be bound by the rules and these conditions and to accept as final and binding all decisions made by the Chief Executive Officer.
- These conditions only summarise some important rules. A complete set of rules is available for inspection at any NSW Lotteries Agency with a computer linked terminal.
